He was an Inspector of Ancient Monuments responsible for research and conservation of monuments in East Anglia and South East England. He has directed major archaeological excavations and identified and evaluated buildings and engineering works of historic and architectural importance in the Royal Navy's operational home bases, sharing his scholarly work in numerous publications.

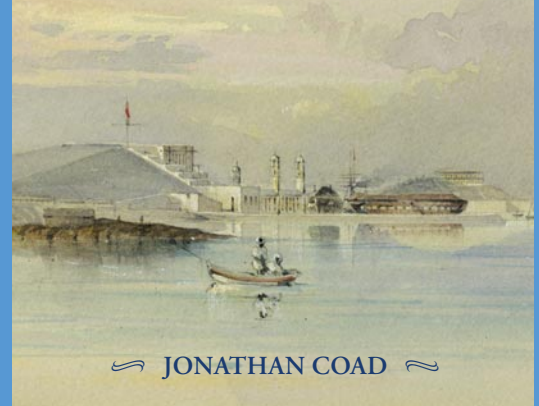
